This class is for Intermediate and Advanced skill levels.

Class Description: : Learn how to lightly wood burn a face by manipulating your burner tool and enhanced with a slight touch of ink dye. Use altered pages on the remaining gourd, giving the face more of a 3-D effect.

Student must bring to class: Students need to bring a clean cut and ready gourd (size 8" high and NO smaller than 25"-27" circumference. If the gourd does not match the height and circumference, it will distort the face. The face is 6-1/2H x 5"W). A temperature controlled wood burner with a small rounded skewer tip will be needed.

Teacher will provide: Tutorial, pattern ready to transfer, scissors, pencils, etc., altered paper, glue mixture, ink dyes, micro brushes, Formula 49, pallets and small paint brushes to use. Also will bring extension cords and power strips.
