Class Description: In this class, you'll design a gourd using both crushed glass and "doodles" as a decorative effect. You'll learn how to carve a recess for inlaying the glass, and will combine this with wood burned (or drawn) doodles in a fun composition.

Student must bring to class: Bring a gourd of any size or shape (perhaps you'd like to experiment this technique to embellish a mask or spirit doll), cleaned inside and out. You may spray paint inside the gourd if you want, spray paint will not be available on class day. Bring a good quality dust mask, a dremel type tool and burs, and a wood burner. If you prefer to draw your designs instead of wood burning, please bring a "Pitt Pen", made by Faber Castell and available at most craft stores. (Sharpies are unsuitable as they will bleed and turn purple under finishes!) If you have a heat gun, please bring it so that we have a few extras and won't have to share the instructor's tool.

Teacher will provide: The teacher will provide class handouts, glue, crushed glass and some basic dyes/coloring products. Students are welcome to bring their own dyes if they prefer! Some gold leafing will be available for class use.
