This class is for Intermediate and Advanced

Class Description: Learn the technique of 3-D effect, under scoring feathers from one group of feathers to another. Learn the depth perception on the body and legs and how to slowly trim off the excess gourd around the eagle after you start carving a section.

Student must bring to class: Students need to bring a wood carver, filigree burr, saburr tooth flame, Dremel burrs (inverted cone #116, #110 & #108. Dremel ball size #107 and #105, temperature controlled wood burner with a small round skew tip, and sand paper, a dust mask and if you have an air filter system it would be appreciated.

Teacher will provide: Tutorial, pattern for transfer, gourd piece, scissors, pencil, etc., glue, ink dye, Formula 49, brushes and stand. Extension cords and power strips. (Teacher comment: Please try to bring the proper inverted cone and ball size, will have only a few for purchase.)
