

**Teacher: Gloria Crane - Carved Ginkgo Bowl \$75
10am to 5pm Thursday, September 22**



Class Description (10 minimum, 15 maximum)

The carved Ginkgo Bowl is a fun class in which students will learn about deep, dimensional carving and how to create the smooth swirled ban, with shallow framed rims and drilled holes of various sizes. Acrylic paints are used in this class and you will learn about highlighting and shading to create the appearance of even deeper carving. Carving safety and the proper use of tools will also be discussed.

Walk-Ins Accepted? Yes, as long as the total number of students don't exceed the maximum of 15 and they have their own tools.

Tools and/or supplies the student must bring to class:

Students need to bring a rotary carver with flexible shaft or a micro motor carver, a Fili-point burr and/or Zip Cutter, (both available only at www.welburngourdfarm.com), and any carving burrs you may have, including diamond burrs, an X-acto knife with sharp blade, dust mask or respirator, eye protection and a mini jigsaw with blades. Also bring any small hand files and sanding sticks you may have and your favorite round medium size paint brush. This is a very dusty class so dress in old clothes and bring an apron.

Materials provided by Teacher:

A "thick" precut and cleaned gourd, acrylic paints, clear sealer, sand paper & canned air for dust removal.
