Class Description (10 minimum, 15 maximum)

This is a fun and easy carving class where you will draw and wood-burn your own unique design, freeform carve within the design, learn how to apply and blend pigment powders to create beautiful washes mimicking fired raku pottery.

Walk-Ins Accepted? Yes, as long as the total number of students don't exceed the maximum of 15 and they have their own tools and gourd.

Tools and/or supplies the student must bring to class:

Please bring a gourd, cut and cleaned, inside and out, no larger than 7" and a minimum 1/4" thick. Bottom should be sanded so that it sits on a table

top. Please bring a good quality dust mask or respirator, a wood-burner with a pen that will burn fine lines, a high speed rotary carver with flexible shaft or a micro motor carver, carving ball burr #191, a heat tool, medium round and 1/4" flat paint brushes and an apron as this class will be a little dusty.

*Note: It is ok to paint the inside of the gourd as we will not be doing deep carving in this class

Materials provided by teacher:

Ink dyes, paint, sand, glues, pigment powders, gloves, sponges, canned air, wet wipes, clear liquid and spray varnish sealers and a step-by-step written tutorial with illustrated photos.
