

STUDENTS WILL CREATE A BATIK GOURD USING BATIK METHODS. WE WILL NOT EMBELISH THE GOURD IN CLASS BUT I WILL GO OVER HOW TO DO IT AT HOME (IF DESIRED). STUDENTS SHOULD BRING A WHOLE OR CUT AND CLEANED GOURD. THIS IS A FUN, LOW STRESS CLASS WITH AMAZING RESULTS! ALWAYS A SELL-OUT CLASS.....COME HAVE FUN!

GOURD SPIRITS ½ DAY

STUDENTS WILL CREATE 3 GOURDS SPIRITS IN CLASS. I WILL HAVE FEATHERS HARVESTED FROM MAUNA KEA AVAILABLE FOR STUDENTS TO ADD INTEREST AND COLOR. WE WILL ALSO CREATE AN OMBRE COLOR FADE ON THE BODY WILL INK DYES. MOULDS WILL BE PROVIDED FOR USE IN CLASS AND AVAILABLE FOR SALE TO STUDENTS AFTER.

GOURD FISH ½ DAY

STUDENTS WILL CREATE AN ADORABLE FISH WALL HANGING. I WILL BRING VUT AND PREPPED GOURDS FOR STUDENTS AND NO TWO WILL LOOK ALIKE! I WILL HAVE SEVERAL FISH SPECIES TO SHOW HOW TO DESIGN AND CHOOSE CHARACTERISTICS WHEN DOING OTHER FISH SPECIES. ALL MATERIALS PROVIDED AND PREPPED, JUST BRING YOUR WOOD BURNER AND CREATIVITY TO MAKE THE FINS!

PINE AND POD ½ DAY

STUDENTS WILL CREATE A BEAUTIFUL GOURD WITH PINE NEEDLES AND GEMS. WE WILL GO OVER BASIC COILING AND HOW TO MANIPULAE THE ROW IN THE CUT OUT. THE GOURD WILL BE COMPLETELY PREPPED AND THE LEAF WILL BE CUT OUT FOR STUDENTS PRIOR TO CLASS. WE WILL ALSO CREATE THE OMBRE INK LOOK AT THE END. BEGINNERS WELCOME!
